The need for education on treating this patient population is apparent. Obesity is a common chronic relapsing disease with an enormous impact on both the patient and society at large. Obesity is not universally viewed as a disease, reflecting a lack of understanding regarding the energy dysregulation and underlying physiologic alterations that lead to weight gain. Many physicians are not confident in their ability to help patients overcome the many barriers to achieving and maintaining a healthy weight.
